

University of East Anglia – Scholarships for the Year 2007

UEA International Scholarships Programme

The University of East Anglia provides **over £500,000 of scholarships** each year to support international students in their studies. The awards are made by individual Schools of Study in the University. All international students (outside the European Union) are considered for a scholarship of between 10% and 50% of tuition fees.

In order to be considered for a UEA scholarship **you do not need to make a separate application**. Please indicate on your application for admission that you wish to be considered for a scholarship.

It is important to **make an application as early as possible** because they are considered as they are received. So apply early to make sure of the best chance of success. If you are granted a scholarship, you will be informed at the time you receive your offer of a place at UEA.

Scholarships are **awarded to students on the basis of academic merit** and are normally for the duration of the period of study - three years for Bachelor and PhD degrees and one year for Masters programmes. They are available from all Schools of Study and across most courses of study.

Students of outstanding academic ability will also be considered for Faculty Scholarship Awards made by the Dean of Faculty, usually in April or May each year. These are highly competitive and prestigious awards.

UEA Norwich Business School Undergraduate Scholarships

Norwich Business School is offering International Student Scholarships worth £1,000 or £2,000 per annum for students applying to the School's undergraduate degree courses.

Bursaries of up to £1000 are available for successful candidates who compete within one of the 5 focus sports. 'All Sport' bursaries are available for people competing in non-focus sports, with up to £500 funding available.

Commonwealth Scholarships Commission Shared Scholarship Scheme (CSCSSS)

Candidates must be from a developing Commonwealth country intending to study a subject of developmental relevance, otherwise unable to pay for their studies and outside the scope of existing support schemes. Overseas Research Students Awards Scheme (ORSAS)

ORSAS helps outstanding postgraduate research students from outside the United Kingdom and EU to study in the UK by providing for some of the costs of their training and supervision. ORSAS awards provide funding to pay the difference, in most cases, between the international student tuition fees and the home /EU student tuition fees charged by the academic institution that the student is or will be attending.

UEA Pharmacy Scholarships

All academically excellent applicants will be considered for a scholarship of at least **£2,000** awarded annually for the duration of the course (4 years). To be eligible for the award you must first apply for admission to the University and be eligible for overseas fees status.

Those students who are offered a scholarship will only receive the award if they select UEA as their Firm choice of University (UF/CF with UCAS) and meet the conditions of their offer.

Those receiving an offer of a place of study will be contacted directly by the School of Chemical Sciences and Pharmacy regarding the award; there is no separate scholarship application procedure.
