What you need to know

When we receive your application form, along with copies of the certificates provided, it will be used to consider you for a place on your chosen course. Should you be unsuitable for your chosen course, the International Admissions team will recommend a more appropriate course for you. After processing your application form, if you meet the entry requirements of the course we will write to you to offer you a place. We will then request a deposit or full fees.

How much is the deposit payment?

£2,000 (or full tuition fees for courses lasting less than 1 academic year). When we have received your deposit or full fees we will then send you a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) number. This is an electronic reference number which is linked to the UKBA visa system. You should take this to the British Embassy or High Commission in your country of residence to support your application for entry clearance to the UK.

What do I need to know about applying for a UK student visa?

To enter the UK as a student, you may need entry clearance, which means you must apply for a student visa at the British Embassy or High Commission in your country. All persons applying for a student visa must produce the following documents to show that they meet the entry requirements:

- a) a valid passport or travel document
- b) a CAS number (dated less than 6 months old) for a full-time course.
- c) bank statements showing enough funds to cover the full tuition fees payable at the College and the costs of living in the UK up to a maximum of 9 months (if applicable) and held in the account for a minimum of 28 days.
- d) Evidence of qualifications used for assessment in initial application.

What if I fail to get a visa?

You will need to consider carefully before applying to the College and if you meet the entry requirements to come to the UK on a (student) visa. If your application for a student visa is unsuccessful, and you wish to apply for a refund you MUST submit a refund application form and a copy of the Visa Refusal document given to you by the office that refused your visa. The reasons for your visa refusal will be taken into consideration by the College when you apply for a refund. If your visa is refused due to lack of preparation and/or forged documents you will not be eligible for a refund.

How much is a refund?

This depends on the application process. Please refer to the offer letter for your specific refund entitlement. £500 of the deposit you paid the College is non-refundable. If you have paid £2,000 as a deposit, and qualify for a refund, only £1,500 will be returned to you.

The College is only able to pay refunds by cheque.

Checklist: have you...

- □ Completed the application form in full.
 □ Attached copies of your certificates/references/visa/passport (including any English Language qualifications) to the application form.
- Read and understood the tuition fees and deposit payable.

If you are unsure about your ability to pay the deposit and tuition fees and whether you meet the requirements of a student visa, we advise you not to apply.
